

Purchase Terms and Conditions:

- Wines are sold in case quantities (OWC original wood case) with a minimum of 6 bottles per wine unless otherwise disclosed or mutually agreed.
- Prices are in Singapore Dollars delivered in bond. Duty, GST and clearance permits to be born by clients separately if they choose to remove from bond for consumption or sale. Storage fees and Insurance costs are the separate responsibility of the client.
- Prices and availability are subject to change and not guaranteed until time of payment and invoicing.
- Full payment is due at time of Invoice. No wines will be ordered, shipped or released without payment.
- Wines will be delivered to a Singapore bonded warehouse and account of buyer's choice with 14-21 working days unless disclosed or mutually agreed otherwise.
- All wines are guaranteed to match the specific wine and described aesthetic condition on the Invoice and will be replaced or refunded if rejected or returned in original condition with 3 days of inspection or receipt. Upon delivery to a storage facility, clients or their assigned agents will be responsible within 3 days to inspect or wines will be deemed accepted.
- All wine is sold "AS IS" where is and is not guaranteed for drinking condition. We undertake the proper safekeeping and storage of wines in our possession and will act in good faith when purchasing wine, but we will not be responsible for the state and condition of wines or whether the wine corresponds to the qualities which might be expected from its description. At our complete discretion, we will consider replacing the remainder of any case sold which is not drinkable.
